The Jet Black StazOn Ink Pad is permanent ink that is great for stamping images you want to watercolor or for stamping on Window Sheets (acetate), cellophane bags, and other nonporous surfaces. Clean stamps with StazOn Cleaner after using StazOn ink. To protect the adhesive on cling stamp labels, rinse cling stamps with water immediately after using StazOn Cleaner.

VersaMark Ink



VersaMark ink appears a few shades darker than the cardstock it's stamped on. That makes it great for creating tone-on-tone or watermark effects. It's also perfect for heat embossing. Use it with embossing powder and a heat tool to heat emboss stamped images.



Craft Ink



Whisper White craft ink is rich, permanent pigment ink that is great for embossing or for creating an opaque look on dark cardstock. Perfect for a chalkboard look on Basic Black Cardstock. You can also use it on wood, fabric, and other materials. The Whisper White Craft Stampin' Pad comes uninked with a Whisper White Craft Ink Refill you can use to ink the pad before use.
